Safety Belt Facts

- ✓ During 2010, 190 people died and 16,712 were injured in traffic crashes in Nebraska.
- ✓ One collision occurs every 16 minutes in Nebraska.
- ✓ One in every 26 licensed drivers in Nebraska will be involved in a motor vehicle collision each year.
- ✓ Of the 166 fatal crashes in Nebraska, 46 or 28% of these crashes were alcohol-related.
- ✓ Motor vehicle crashes cost Nebraska over \$663,132,200 annually using 2009 National Safety Council calculable costs of motor vehicle crashes.
- ✓ Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death for people between the ages of 5 and 34.
- ✓ 46 people were injured each day in motor vehicle crashes in Nebraska during 2010 and one person was killed every 46 hours.
- ✓ The observed safety belt use rate in 2010 for drivers and passengers was 84 percent.
- ✓ Safety belts cut the risk of death or serious injury in a crash by 45 to 50 percent.
